

# Carnival in Xaghra 2010



**Friday 12th February 2010: The Folkloristic Carnival.**

**From 7.00pm onwards: In Victory Square, a folkloristic event takes places with the participation of Gozitan folk groups. The traditional dance 'Il-Kumittiva' and 'Il-Ġostru' will be presented. A glass of local wine will be given to those present. The compères of the event will be Mr. Anthony Grech and Mrs. Orietta Gatt.**



**Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February: Children's Carnival.**

**From 7.30pm onwards: In Nazzarenu square, the children's carnival is organised. Six competitions will be held:**

- (a) Category A - Best Costume (children till 5 years);**
- (b) Category B – Best Costume (children between 6 and 11 years of age);**
- (c) Category C – Best Costume (children from 11 years of age onwards);**
- (d) Category D – *Foam* Costumes;**
- (e) Category E – Competition for the best decorated agricultural tractor;**
- (f) Category F – Competition for the best spontaneous Carnival costume.**



**The traditional dance 'Il-Kumittiva' will be presented. An animation team presents a lot of games by which children and all those present have can fun together in a friendly atmosphere. Local traditional food, such as *il-ftira*, can be purchased. A glass of local wine will be given to those present. Mr. Joe Louis Sciberras and Ms. Amanda Sultana will be the compères of the event.**
